## PETITION FOR REVIEW OF FINAL AGENCY ACTION

Petitioners Independent Petroleum Association of America ("IPAA") and Western Energy Alliance ("the Alliance") submit respectfully this petition for review of final agency action under the Administrative Procedure Act, 5 U.S.C. §§ 701-706 ("APA") and Local Civil Rule 83.6. On March 20, 2015, the federal Bureau of Land Management ("BLM") issued a final

rule intended to regulate hydraulic fracturing associated with oil and gas development on federal

and Indian lands. See Docket ID BLM-2013-0002, Regulatory Information Number 1004-

AE26.1

BLM's rulemaking represents a reaction to unsubstantiated concerns and the

administrative record lacks the factual, scientific, or engineering evidence necessary to sustain

the agency's final rule. The rulemaking has been procedurally deficient and the final rule as

issued is contrary to law. Because the regulatory conditions the final rule imposes constitute

arbitrary and unnecessary burdens that either duplicate state law requirements or improperly

curtail the primary jurisdiction of state governments, and because the regulations are not properly

tailored to achieve a legitimate government purpose, the Court should find the rule invalid and

set aside the challenged agency action.

This Court has federal-question jurisdiction over this petition under 28 U.S.C. § 1331.

Respondent Sally Jewell is an officer of the United States; Respondent BLM is an entity of the

United States Government. The United States has waived its sovereign immunity under the

APA, 5 U.S.C. § 704.
